SEVEN LAYER SALAD

| 1 head lettuce, torn in bits | 2 c mayonnaise |
| 1 c diced celery | 2 Tbsp sugar |
| 4 hard cooked eggs, sliced | 4 oz grated cheddar cheese |
| 1 - 10 oz pkg frozen peas (do not cook) | |
| 1/2 c diced green pepper | |
| 1 medium onion, diced | |
| 8 slices of bacon, cooked & crumbled | |

Layer first seven ingredients in 9x13 glass dish or any decorative glass dish. Mix sugar & mayonnaise and spread over top as frosting. Top with grated cheese. Cover & refrigerate 8-12 hours.



TIPS FOR SAFE GRILLING

Warmer weather means more outdoor activities, especially grilling. Whether you have a complete outdoor kitchen or a portable grill, please keep in mind the following safety tips:

- Keep the top open when lighting a grill.
- Do not use matches or lighters to check for leaks.
- Remove combustible materials from grilling area. Never pour accelerants on the grill, such as gasoline or lighter fluid.
- When finished grilling, turn off the burner controls and close the cylinder valve.
- Cover disconnected hose-end fillings with protective caps or plastic when the grill is not in use.
- Store propane cylinders outdoors in an upright (vertical) position.

If you need to fill your tank, purchase a spare tank, or have a tank re-qualified, please stop by our facility at 27 West Main Street in Mountville, Monday through Friday, 7:30am to 5:00pm.
